- Minimum Qualifications & Common Course Numbering (CCN) Follow-up. Asked about the impact of CCN and minimum qualifications.
 - i. Response was: Minimum Qualifications is a local decision. We will need to separate our Subject code from the min quals (which some colleges have historically done). Chicano Studies (faculty) will still need to locally decide to revise (ESTU) or don't revise their course for CCN.
