The Community Advisory Committee was established to strengthen partnerships between the Compton College District Police Department and stakeholders throughout the surrounding community while promoting campus safety, transparency, and meaningful community engagement.

Committee Responsibilities

The Community Advisory Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police and shall:

- Promote open communication between the Compton College District Police Department and the community;
- Provide community perspectives and feedback regarding campus safety initiatives and public safety practices;
- Support transparency, accountability, and public trust through constructive dialogue;
- Encourage collaboration on issues affecting campus safety and community well-being;
- Foster positive relationships between the Police Department, students, employees, and surrounding communities;
- Provide recommendations, when appropriate, to strengthen community engagement efforts.

The Chief of Police, or their designee, will serve as the facilitator for all Committee meetings.

Committee Membership

The Committee shall consist of **six (6) members** appointed to represent a broad cross-section of the community. Membership may include, but is not limited to:

- District residents
- Senior citizens
- Faith and community leaders
- Parents or guardians of Compton College students
- Local business owners
- Advocates for youth and community well-being

The District seeks members who demonstrate a commitment to public service, community engagement, and collaborative problem-solving.

Time Commitment

The Community Advisory Committee shall meet no more than three (3) times during each fiscal year. Additional meetings may be scheduled only if deemed necessary by the Chief of Police or their designee.
