 8. Promotes collaboration between colleagues, not only on one campus, but on both.

- **Campus Climate/Winter Surveys:** Presentation by Irene Graff from the IR (Institutional Research) office. Findings include:
 1. 66% of surveyed Compton Center students were in favor of keeping Winter Intersession.
 2. 99% of surveyed Compton Center faculty felt that the partnership was important.
 3. 75% of surveyed CC faculty agreed that the partnership was good for the Center.
