High School Seniors Encouraged to Apply Now for Summer and Fall 2017 at El Camino College Compton Center

Early Registration Available to New Students

With eyes on her dream university UCLA, Elizabeth Elizondo of Lynwood High School recently enrolled at El Camino College Compton Center as a pathway to accomplish her educational plans. “El Camino College Compton Center was my first choice to begin my college education because it is close, affordable, and has a good reputation for assisting students with their transfer goals,” said Elizondo, who will graduate from high school this June. She will officially become a student at ECC Compton Center this summer when she will take an English class.

In-district high school seniors and college bound students are encouraged to apply immediately for admission to El Camino College Compton Center for summer and fall 2017.

Priority registration is available to students living within the Compton Community College District and graduates, from high schools within the district, who complete all four steps to enroll at ECC Compton Center before April 28, 2017. The Compton Community College District includes: Compton, Lynwood, Paramount and Willowbrook, as well as portions of Athens, Bellflower, Carson, Downey, Dominguez, Lakewood, North Long Beach and Southgate.

“I see a lot of students wait until the last minute to begin the enrollment process,” said Keith Curry, provost for El Camino College Compton Center. “My recommendation is to not put off what you can easily do right now. Students who complete the steps to enroll and register for classes early will get the classes they need to stay on track to graduate on time.”

Current high school seniors interested in attending ECC Compton Center for summer or fall 2017 are encouraged to apply and complete all four of the required Steps to Enrollment as early as possible, even if they haven’t made their final decision about higher education.

“Enrollment was a fairly simple process because I attended the ECC Compton Center outreach sessions at my high school, which helped me with the steps to enroll,” said Elizondo. “I’m excited to attend Compton Center, and I’m glad I enrolled early so I can get the classes I need to transfer successfully.”
