Each new faculty member brings extensive professional and academic expertise that will enhance student learning and help inspire students to create their own success story in the classroom and beyond.

Domenic Capozzolo

Reading instructor. Domenic Capozzolo earned a master's degree in English education and a second master's degree in the reading specialist program, both from Columbia University's Teachers College. He received his bachelor's degree in English literature from University of Southern California. Capozzolo has held various positions teaching English at the high school and college levels. He previously served as an English instructor at Saddleback High School and Mendocino High School, and English instructor/SAT tutor at Spartan Academy and Advance Prep Academy. In addition, he was an English instructor for Loyola Marymount University's Upward Bound Math and Science program for Los Angeles Unified School District students.

Don Mason

Administration of Justice instructor. Don Mason earned his doctoral degree in organization leadership from Grand Canyon University; a master's degree in education from Capella University; and a bachelor's degree in education from Southern Illinois University at Carbondale. He began his career in law enforcement – first as a sheriff with the Orange County Sheriff's Department and later as a police officer and sergeant with the Los Angeles School District Police. Mason then transitioned from police officer to professor. He served as an instructor and lecturer in administration of justice at Rio Hondo College, El Camino College and California State University, Los Angeles. Most recently, Mason served as the associate dean of the Business and Public Safety Division at Rio Hondo College. During his time there, he also held positions as interim dean of Arts, Cultural Programs and Continuing Education as well as associate professor/program coordinator for the online administration of justice and corrections programs.
