



STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

All new students are required to complete the Steps to Enrollment prior to registering for classes at Compton College.

APPLY FOR ADMISSION

www.compton.edu/Admission

Take the first step – it's fast and easy! Complete and submit your free application online.

- New and returning students (those with an absence of two consecutive primary terms: fall or spring semesters; excluding summer and winter terms) must complete an online application for admission.
- A Student ID number will be issued and emailed upon completion of the online application.
- Official transcripts from all accredited colleges and trade schools attended must be submitted to the Admissions & Records Office (Building A). Students applying for Advanced Placement credit must submit official high school transcripts.
