


1. To access free online tutoring support from EdReady first login to your **MyCompton** portal from the <u>Compton</u>



2. From your MyCompton homepage click on the Learning Resources tile.




College Homepage.

3. On the Learning Resources page click on the **EdReady** tile. This will take you to the Compton College EdReady homepage.






4. On the EdReady Compton College homepage click on Enter As Guest.




5. A dialogue box will appear asking you to enter your zip code. You can either enter your zip code and then click **Enter** or leave the box blank and click **Enter**.

6. On the next page you will see a dialogue box that says Welcome to EdReady. Click on Get Started.






Please note goal names are subject to change.
