As a student, there are nights that I really don't feel safe walking to the bus stop at Artesia. The reason is because I don't feel safe with young people who do not go to school here. They seem to hang out on Artesia Blvd and that makes me feel unsafe. What can be done to make me feel safe going home?

I appreciate the active shooter information presented at the safety forum that can also be delivered to the students, fellow workers and families. I appreciate if this information is shared to students in a kind of organized meeting instead of going to class.

Please include Psych Services to the New Molina Clinic on campus.

#### Student,

It would be nice if we had a list of the emergency building captains for each row or department. That way we would know who should be in charge in case of an emergency as well if we need a backup in case that person is not present.

#### Staff,

I like seeing squad cars in the parking lot by the Math and Science Bldg later in the evening. We could post maps which include evacuation routes, fire extinguishers, and AEDs. Would it be safe to carry pepper spray on campus? I would like to be

able to text campus police in case I have an issue in my class room and need to stay there but to be discreet about an issue.

#### Staff,

ECC notifies campus news of incidents, why doesn't Compton do this as well? Provide practical strategies for instructors to use for Active Shooter, not Keenan or a video during flex, not as a choice because we have to attend meetings. Provide more visibility of officers or trainees on campus for night faculty and staff. Perhaps officers who do not catty guns just have more security staff? Phones, cameras or videos are not available in all areas and locations and this may be the most beneficial to the college.

What should I do if I am at work and there is an earthquake and I am away from my family? What can I do in advance to be prepared for an earthquake?
