Campus Community,

As of April 28, 2020, there are a total of 46,500 positive cases and 1,887 deaths in California. For more information, go to https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/Immunization/ncov2019.aspx (https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/Immunization/ncov2019.aspx).

Compton College remains operating at **Level Four - Severe Infection Rate**, according to the Compton CCD Pandemic Outbreak - Emergency Operations Plan (/adminandoperations/campuspolice/Documents/Pandemic-Outbreak_Emergency-Operations-Plan.pdf). The Compton College Pandemic Coordinators and members of the President/CEO Cabinet met this week, and below are current updates.

Compton College Critical Personnel Necessary for Essential Functions

Compton College remains closed to visitors and the general public. To protect our community and slow the spread of COVID-19, all essential employees must follow social distancing protocol, which includes wearing a face covering while performing duties that involve contact with others. Please note, for those employees authorized to be on campus, the campus closes at 4:30 p.m. On Wednesdays, only Maintenance & Operations staff are allowed on campus past 4:30 p.m., with the last shift ending at 6:30 p.m.

You will be required to follow the social distancing protocol, as mentioned above.

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act

The CARES Act establishes the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund, which includes flexible funding to help institutions with immediate needs related to coronavirus. Compton College will be receiving \$2,538,405 in one-time funding to defray expenses such as lost revenue and technology costs associated with transitioning to alternative academic instruction. Fifty percent of that money (\$1,269,202.50) must be used to provide direct Emergency Aid to Students (https://www2.ed.gov/about/offices/list/ope/heerfstudentfaqs.pdf), including grants for food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare, and child care. Up to 50 percent of the Institutional Share (https://www2.ed.gov/about/offices/list/ope/heerfinstitutionalfaqs.pdf) may be used to cover costs associated with significant changes to the delivery of instruction due to the coronavirus. Below is a draft of the spending plan.

The draft spending plan focuses on providing as much financial assistance as possible to support our students. Guidance released by the United States Department of Education indicates that students must be eligible for Title IV to receive emergency grants. This narrow definition only includes:

- U.S. citizens or eligible noncitizens
- Students with valid SSN
- Students registered with the selective service
- Students with a high school diploma or GED
- Programs leading to a degree or certificate

The plan is to spend the CARES Act funds from the current semester through June 30, 2021. Furthermore, we will allocate funding from Student Equity and Achievement to provide emergency grants and other support to AB 540 students. More information will be provided in a future Compton College COVID-19 Update on the emergency grants and additional support that will be provided to AB 540 students. 
