# Accreditation Timeline

- The Compton College [Accreditation Steering Committee](#) (ASC) is preparing for the next seven-year accreditation cycle that will start in 2024.
- The ASC has established a [detailed timeline](#) to guide the completion of the next Institutional Self- Evaluation Report (ISER).
- Spring 2023 ISER Milestones:
  - February 2023– [Draft posted online and community feedback collected.](#)
  - March 2023 – Another draft sent to constituent groups for first read and additional feedback.
  - April 2023 – Final draft of ISER made public, collect comments
  - June 2023 – Final draft submitted to CCCD Board of Trustees for first read
- July 20, 2023 – ISER submitted to ACCJC

# Accreditation Update

- The ASC is now establishing its first master draft of the ISER, reviewing all standards.
  - The master draft will be reviewed two more times before it is prepared for public review in spring 2023.
- The ASC will continue to host monthly meetings.

# Construction

**Student Services Building:** The \$25.2 million facility will become a one-stop hub for all student services. The project involves the demolition of the old Library building, and construction of the new Student Services Building.

**Instructional Building 2:** The \$25.6 million project involves the removal of Row Building D, the remainder of Row E and F buildings, and the construction of a second state-of-the-art instructional building on campus.
