## Compton College Evaluation of Institution-Set Goals Spring 2019

The 2019-20 goals are based upon what we expect to see within one year to total a 20% or more increase over three years to contribute to the Vision for Success Goal of a 20% increase in completions and 35% increase in transfers by 2020-21. Compton College stakeholders agreed to increase the goal of students who complete transfer level English and math in the first year to the state average (27% and 11% respectively), as shown below.

Note: College stakeholders defined the 2019-20 Goals as aspirational and achievable. The College has also set standards for a sub-set of measures, which are noted in the metric title if applicable. Standards are thresholds that we do not want to dip below, and if that occurs, it will trigger the College's immediate action.
