Important Compton College Updates:

- 1. Compton College will extend alternative academic instruction and online student support services, and telecommuting through Friday, June 12, 2020.
- 2. There will be no classes held April 11-17, 2020 during Spring Break.
- 3. The first six-week and eight-week summer sessions will be offered via alternative academic instruction options. The second six-week summer session will be offered on-campus and online via alternative academic instruction. - 4. The 2020 Compton College Commencement Ceremony will be a pre-recorded commencement ceremony, including keynote speeches and 10-15 second videos from each graduate.
