Scorecard (ARCC 2.0)

- Accountability report mandated by AB1417 since 2007
- Revised in 2013 in response to Student Success
 Task Force
- Four-tiered accountability framework:
 - 1. <u>CCC System</u> report
 - 2. <u>Scorecard</u> for each college
 - 3. Data Mart access to further disaggregation
 - Data-on-Demand dataset downloads for further analysis

System Report – 2013 Highlights

- 167,946 certificates/degrees system-wide
- Effects of budget constraints:
 - Enrolled students dropped 22% in 5 years
 - CSU transfers declined by 20%
- College readiness linked to completion:
 - 71% of prepared students complete, while only 41% of unprepared students do.
 - 77% of students are unprepared for college.

Definitions


COLLEGE PREPARED: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/or English was college level

OVERALL: Student attempted any level of Math or English in the first three years




Percentage of 2012-13 Cohort Unprepared for College






Completion Rates


Three-Term Persistence Rates



Among those whose first record in the CCC system is at El Camino College who are degree-, certificate-, and/or transfer-seeking students: the percentage who enrolled in three consecutive terms from first enrollment, anywhere in the CCC system.




30-Units Completion Rates



Among those whose first record in the CCC system is at El Camino College who are degree-, certificate-, and/or transfer-seeking students: the percentage who achieved at least 30 units anywhere in the CCC system within six years.




Remedial Progress Rates



Among credit students whose first attempt of below-transfer-level English, Math, and/or ESL in the CCC system is at El Camino College: the percentage who completed a college-level course in the same discipline anywhere in the CCC system within six years.



Career and Technical Education Completion Rates



Among those whose first attempt of a CTE course in the CCC system is at El Camino College and completed more than eight units in courses classified as career technical education (or vocational) in a single discipline: the percentage who completed a degree or certificate, or who transferred anywhere in the CCC system within six years.
