- IV) Agenda Items
 - a) Review of Flex Day Panel discussion – Katherine Marsh
Members of the OER Committee presented at the Optional Flex Day at the beginning of the Spring Semester. Faculty expressed a lot of interested and support for ZTC and OER.
 - b) OER committee website – Abby Tatlilioglu
Find the OER Committee website is difficult. We should include more than just meeting information, resources should be added to the page to ensure faculty *and* students are able to understand what OER is and how it benefits them. Suggestions to improve the website included: promoting OER workshops, list Compton College ZTC and OER courses and disciplines.
Seymour – The school is in the process of updating the website and the OER committee should contact Heather Parnock to make recommendations.

- c) OER handbook going to senate – Katherine Marsh
Susan Johnson motions to vote on approving the handbook and forward it the Academic Senate;

- d) Customizing OER in LibreText (remixed OER) – Abby Tatliogliu
ASCCC conducting a series of workshops to train faculty on how to remix OER to incorporate into faculty’s classes. Workshop sign up links posted on Dr. Mathews Distance Education newsletter sent out on March 21st. The ASCCC-OERI page hosts previous workshops that are available to anyone interested.

- e) Workgroup Update – Abby Tatliogliu
Workgroup met over the winter and working on developing a document to address OER at Compton. Questions that the Workgroup has been attempting to solve include: How to continue training? Will there be a “champion” to advocate for OER on campus? Will it be a paid position? The Workgroup is also developing ideas on how to best incorporate student voices. The Workgroup is still working on developing faculty incentives to transition and develop to OER.
- f) Low-Cost course labeling and advertising for both Low-cost and ZTC – Abby Tatliogliu
Compton College does not currently have a “Low-Cost Course” label. This should be included in class marketing/scheduling materials for student considerations.
The committee discussed how to define low cost and whether this was something that could a blanket cost across disciplines; and whether a special liaison should be appointed.
Mathews – A list of all textbook costs at Compton College is available and it could be used to determine how to best determine what “low-cost” means.
- g) OER/ZTC degree pathway – Abby Tatliogliu
Engineering Technology and Engineering Technician certificates are fully ZTC. There are currently a couple disciplines that are close to becoming fully OER and could offer certificates. The Workgroup is working on developing ZTC/OER pathways to assist departments on developing OER pathways.
- h) OER Workshops/Webinars/Events – Abby Tatliogliu
OER Fundamentals training is in its final week. After Spring Break, the OER Train the Trainer workshops will begin.

- i) Sharing out of OER victories – committee
Gayathri – Two math classes have been changed to be fully OER.
Gonzales – Will be incorporating LibreText textbooks for future Political Science courses to make them ZTC.
