a) <u>Cool4Ed Resource</u> and <u>Compton College's OER page</u> – Katherine Marsh & Abby Tatillogiu
 a) <u>Cool4Ed Resource</u> and <u>Compton College's OER page</u> – Katherine Marsh & Abby Tatlilioglu 1) Cool4Ed is a collaboration between the CCC, UC's, and CSU's in which open resources are organized by CID and compiled by discipline. Faculty can find CID specific material that has been adopted across the State. (i) Cool4Ed can be found here: <u>https://www.cool4ed.org/course-showcase</u> 2) Compton College now has a hub on the OER Commons. The site was developed by ISKME and is a repository where the faculty can share OER materials with other faculty. Megan Simmons from ISKME helped set up the hub. Faculty can see materials used by other faculty including CCC and K-12/Common Core materials. Compton College can use this space to curate materials for our faculty.

- 3) Discussion:
 - (i) Tatlilioglu We should consider developing our own repository on Campus where Compton College faculty can share the material they use and encourage hesitant faculty to adopt OER materials.

b) OER Committee Webpage – Abby Tatlilioglu

- 1) Gayathri Can we record our meetings and publish them on the Committee page? We can include Minutes and Agenda so that members can follow up and provide links to resources for faculty.
- 2) Marsh Yes, we can record and use the website as a resource for our materials.

c) OERI Summer Workshops – Katherine Marsh

- 1) The State Academic Senate is providing free OER training. The training consists of two 90minute sessions.
- 2) Marsh Training over the Summer break would prepare faculty for the Fall 2021 semester. Proposed dates for the training are:
 - (i) June 25 and July 2
 - (ii) July 2 and July 9
 - (iii)July 9 and July 16
- 3) Discussion
 - (i) The Committee agreed that providing these workshops would be best in the summer, but not on Fridays as proposed due to campus being closed. The Committee also decided that a flyer would go out to faculty to advertise the event and to announce the dates at upcoming Department meetings.
 - (ii) The committee decided to hold the training sessions during the Summer break on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 29, 2021 and Tuesday</u>, <u>July 6, 2021</u>.

d) OER Action Plan Workgroup – Katherine Marsh

- The Committee welcomes Ryan Erickson-Kulas, representative from the Michaelson 20MM Foundation. The foundation provided \$25,000 to Compton College to develop OER materials on campus. Mr. Erickson-Kulas is joining our meeting to see how we can best develop our Action Plan.
- 2) The Committee presented the Action Plan which seeks to achieve a 100% rate in OER/ZTC adoption rate by 2035. The Committee Presented the Approach to Action Plan Development (see attached). The Committee is also working with the Institute for the Study of Knowledge and Management in Education (ISKME) to assist in the development of the OER Action Plan for Compton College.
- 3) Mr. Erickson-Kulas asked the following questions:
 - (i) The group that will be putting the plan for the December deadline will consist of 8-10 workgroup from different pools, do you also envision this group to continually meet on an ongoing fashion to support?
 - (a) Marsh: Yes. The workgroup will probably have the bigger burden of work and will probably have the most hours.





- (ii) Where has OER been the most successful on campus? Where do you envision the most challenge?
 - (a) The consensus was that some disciplines do not yet have the proper OER materials available now and other disciplines do not have specialized OER materials.
- (iii)What if any conversation or formal declarations have been made by the local Academic Senate around OER and their intentions of being supportive of the OER initiative?
 - (a) The OER Committee has the full support of the Academic Senate and is sub-committee of the Academic Senate.
- *(iv) What do you see as common concerns that fellow faculty will often raise as to why they're opposed to switching other than there are no resources?*
 - (a) The consensus was that faculty are concerned about the amount of work OER materials would require since they do not have the ancillary materials publishers provide for faculty. Most faculty are more comfortable with the materials they are currently using.
- (v) Do you feel that fellow faculty would be willing to use content that was developed by a Compton college peer rather than something was created elsewhere?
 - (a) The feeling is that faculty would be more comfortable if the materials used at Compton College were developed on campus. This could facilitate the adoption process.
- 4) Dr. Curry added that he wishes that our Action Plan could serve as a model that other schools can use. He believes that we are best positioned to serve as a model campus for the area and the country.
- e) Sharing out of OER victories Abby Tatlilioglu
 - 1) English is working together to write OER.
 - 2) Tatlilioglu Found and shared resources for Math courses via Lumen OHM which had low-cost textbooks rather than ZTC. Resources sent to faculty and department. Some faculty responded and supported the adoption, others are taking wait and see approach.
