 - i) A team was put together for training in Antiracism in OER

 - i) American Colleges & University Training: It is a year-long program. Team has been assembled
 - e) ZTC Grant Program – Airek Mathews
 - i) Every college received infusion of \$20,000 for planning.
 - ii) There are multiple phases of the program
 - Phase 1 is for colleges that are immediately ready
 - Phase 2 & 3 is for colleges that require more longtime planning (ex: ZTC program planning)
 - iii) Dr. Matthews shared a list of current programs that are close to readiness
 - iv) Must explain how Compton College pathways are distinct from neighboring colleges that use similar OER and Instruction practices
 - v) Program must be up and running by 2024

- f) setting a definition for “low cost” – Airek Mathews
 - i) Still in development. Needs to be a part of our application
 - ii) Current recommendation for “low cost” designation is \$40 or less
 - Needs to be forwarded to Academic Senate before approval
 - iii) Need information on degrees that are high impact (affecting larger student populations).
 - General Studies & General Science have highest degree conferral rates.
 - Political Science and History have low degree conferral rates
 - iv) Need recommendations from the OER committee on how we move forward
