Self-Evaluation of Committee Goals and Tasks Accreditation Steering Committee – Spring 2022

Purpose

Outcomes

After the completion of this activity the ASC will be able to:

1. Describe the connection between the goals of the ASC and the College's strategic initiatives and the Tartar Completion by Design framework in greater detail,
2. Determine which of the goals are progressing and which require more attention, and
3. Develop new ideas for potential ASC goals for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Activities

For activities Part One through Part Three below, please use the Committee Self-Evaluation form from the Office of Institutional Effectiveness.

1. Part One – Please review your group's assigned ASC goal and sub-tasks and align each to the College's Strategic Initiatives and Tartar Completion by Design framework.

3. Part Three – Evaluate whether the ASC was successful in meeting its yearly goals; identify any gaps.
4. Part Four – Reflect upon and discuss the ASC's 2021-2022 goals. Based on these, begin drafting new goals for the 2022-2023 academic year. These will be finalized and voted up for adoption in August 2022.

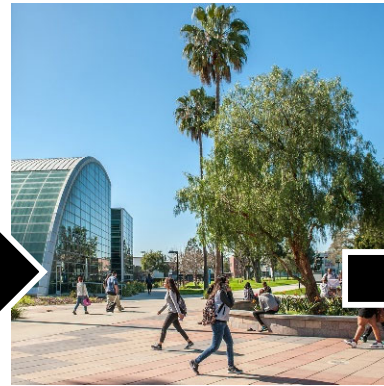
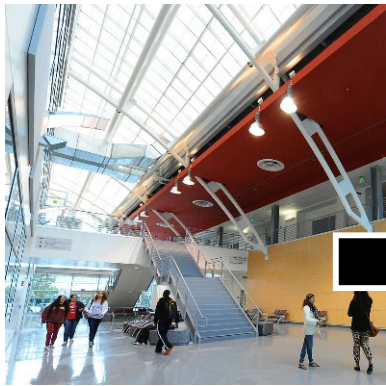
