MEETING MINUTES

- 1. Review Minutes from April 3, 2017 Rescheduled to be reviewed at the April 24th meeting.
- 2. Team Reports: Cancelled
- 3. Provost/CEO Updates
 - a. Dr. Curry reported there will be a Strategic Planning Committee Meeting on Friday, April 28th, from 8:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. at the Reef Restaurant in Long Beach.
 - b. The Enrollment Management Summit will be held on Friday, May 12, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. 12:00 noon.
 - c. The CEO announced the Accreditation 101 Workshop will be held on May 16, 2017, from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m. in the Staff Lounge.
 - d. Student Transportation Metro U-PASS Ms. Martinez stated that she wants to start selling bus passes in September; currently about 200 bus passes are sold each semester, and she is working on trying to get a subsidy to help lower the cost to students.
 - Dr. Curry is meeting with local cities to ask for reduced bus pass rates for our students. He is also working on Uber and Lyft to provide services to this campus and to designate pick-up spots around the campus. In addition, Dr. Curry wants to provide valet service for the first two weeks of each semester. He is also working on getting the Compton City Shuttle to come here from each high school in our service area.
 - e. Assembly Bill 1732; Single-User Restrooms Implementation to be discussed at the Mary 8, 2017 meeting.
 - f. Health Benefits Committee Recommendations Dr. Curry distributed and reviewed an email from CalPERS regarding their administrative fees. Dr. Curry has reviewed the information provided by CalPERS and a CalPERS representative will give a presentation to the Board on April 19, 2017.

g. The Consultative Council will be asked for their recommendation at the meeting on April 24, 2017. VEBA offers Kaiser and Health Net. A VEBA representative will also give a presentation on their plan to the Board on April 29, 2017.

Dr. Curry will create a chart comparing VEBA and CalPERS. Health Net is cheaper than VEBA, and the CEO will make a recommendation at the May 9, 2017 Special Board Meeting. There will be a campus-wide meeting on Wednesday, May 3, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. in the Little Theater, during which we will discuss the selection process and address any questions you may have regarding

CalPERS and VEBA. If you would like to provide the CEO with additional information on the Compton District Health Benefits, please send him an email.
