1. Minutes of April 23, 2018 – Approved.

 - B. Police Department Chief Trevis, and Lt. Box promised an update on the Police Department and their 207-2018 Budget.

There was also a discussion of campus police overtime. The District is working with a consultant regarding police salaries when the District has completely separated from ECC. He also reported that the District will not be adding any positions, although we currently have only five (of seven) campus police positions filled. He suggested hiring a security officer (unarmed) for evening duty.

Mr. Yahye expressed his concerns about the safety of cars parked behind the Voch Tech building; fencing is not secure and cars are parked close to the fence.

Dr. Curry stated that the exterior fencing needs to be replaced, but concerned about how to pay for this project. He will ask Ms. Owens to get a quote for this project, and to attend the May 7th Consultative Council meeting
