1. Reviewed minutes from March 9, 2020 – Tabled to the next meeting.
2. President/CEO Items
 - A. Update on COVID-19 – Amber Gillis reported that faculty is pulling it together. What does this mean to students? Mental health resources have been offered to students, and other resource information is being distributed.

Dr. Keith Curry stated they are trying to figure out more information on the CARE Act, and the impacts COVID -19 might have on a Compton College students Financial Aid.

Christopher Perez said he has talked to ASB and reports that this is bringing up some challenges regarding housing for the homeless students and are looking for stable locations. Also, many students do not have internet access, but generally they can check their Compton email account.

Dr. Curry asked Chris Perez to please document these conversations he has with students and share with Vice President Elizabeth Martinez.

Chris said he will do so and students are still trying to understand the process.

Linda Coleman stated that she is working closely with payroll.

Christopher Perez stated that students need more training on Zoom and also on the Cranium Café. Dr. Curry asked him to follow-up with Elizabeth Martinez.

Dr. Curry will send out updated information on COVID-19 on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
 - B. Compton College Achieving the Dream Application – Dr. Curry reported the Achieving the Dream application has been approved by the Compton Academic Senate, the Board of Trustees, and will be sent to Achieving the Dream Inc. Dr. Curry will keep us posted.
 - C. Compton College Guided Pathways Application - Compton College was admitted to the second

cohort for the California Guided Pathways Project. More information will be provided at a later meeting.

3. Facilities Update – Linda Owens provided an update on the Compton College Facilities Projects. Linda Owens is in the process of scheduling meetings for the Performing Arts Complex and Vocational Technology Building Projects. Also, Linda Owens is waiting for a report from the architects regarding the proposed renovations to the Adult Schools to provided our Career and Technical Education Programs. Linda Owens will follow-up with Compton Unified School District since they were using their own architect.
