- d) Professor Hobgood suggested that New Student Orientation provide students with study tools, this can help increase our passage rates.
 - i) Study tools and classroom tools are very important as there was an issue brought up at some of the high schools that students do not know how to fill in scantrons. – Dr. Nelly Alvarado
- e) Some of his suggestions are things we are already working on; however, his suggestions bring up the need to imbed these things into Guided Pathways and New Student Orientation
- f) Professor Hobgood suggested that student ambassadors focus on STEM. Vice President Martinez directed him to talk to the Tartar Success Teams as they have proposals for outreach events.
- g) He suggested a free ride service for students. We help students with reduced costs transportations and categorical programs offer transportation support as well.
- h) He wants more student clubs; Vice President Martinez will forward these club suggestions to Elizabeth Elizondo.
- Professor Hobgood's information was forwarded to Dean Jimenez and Dean Blonshine so he can contact them regarding early alert as he also wants to be involved in that process.
