- c) Each Tartar Success Team will receive \$10,000 in funding.
- d) The Program Proposal Template was reviewed and sent out to the Committee.

**5) SOAA Dates and Assignments**

- a) The Scale of Adoption Assessment (SOAA) is the second version of the statewide Guided Pathways assessment planning tool used by the California Community Colleges and was adopted in Spring 2019.
- b) The SOAA tool itself is designed to help stakeholders at the college assess and address how far along they are in adopting essential guided pathways practices at scale.
  - a) Four Pillars of Guided Pathways:
    - i) (1) Clarify the Path: Mapping Pathways to Student End Goals;
    - ii) (2) Enter the Path: Helping Students Choose and Enter a Program Pathway;
    - iii) (3) Stay on the Path: Keeping Students on the Path; and
    - iv) (4) Ensure Learning: Ensuring that Students Are Learning.
  - b) Each of these pillars also include a series of equity considerations to help spark dialogue and help keep an equity focus in these guided pathways efforts.
    - a) It must be signed by Academic Senate President and College President via the Nova reporting system.
    - b) SOAA is due by March 1, 2021
    - c) Academic Senate deadline – December 3, 2020.
