- 2) **Eventual Return to Campus Plan** – Heather Parnock, Director, Community Relations / Pandemic Coordinators Update
 - a) The plan is being updated but we are waiting on updates from Athletics as well as updates to the guidelines from the County, State and Federal level. There will be no on campus classes other than the CTE Classes in the Winter & Spring. The Spring Class schedule is being finalized. Discussion was held regarding feedback for Summer 2021 classes
- 3) **Review of Follow-up Items from the Previous Meeting(s)**
 - a) COVID-19 Updates Area E – Disaster Area Management Coordinator (DMAC)
Chief Box emailed the committee a link from DMAC regarding Thanksgiving concerns, on this webpage there is a short video about things you can do to be safe during this pandemic and during the Thanksgiving holiday. Chief Box asked everyone to please review it and if you have any questions to please email him.
 - b) Review Emergency Operations Plan for Compton College
Chief Box reminded everyone that the EOP is online on the District website, he said that he knows it is very dry, but it is very important that the committee members are familiar with it and that he is available by email if anyone has any questions regarding the EOP.
 - c) Update on the Great California ShakeOut Earthquake Drill 2020
Chief Box provided an update on the Great ShakeOut for 2020. He stated this was the first

virtual event and that we were unable to do a full evacuation, but we were able to test our Nixle Alert System, Emergency Blue Poles (E-Poles) and Cisco Phone Alert system, everything went well, and I know not a lot of you were present. Please make sure you have an emergency plan for home because a disaster may occur at home. CB gave tips in the event of a Disaster.

Following the update by Chief Box, Student Trustee Benson Atkins expressed how happy he was with how the system worked, he said he had it all set up on his phone and it worked well and that he is proud of the Police Department and its staff.
