  - a) COVID 19 Updates:

Heather Parnock reported on behalf of the Pandemic Coordinators and reported that College is looking to allow 225 invited student who need to make up lab credits from the Spring 2020 semester to return to the campus on July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Prior to them returning to campus they would need to be tested for COVID-19 along having their temperatures taken. Currently the Maintenance & Operations Department is finishing their training to clean and disinfect the buildings, this will also the building to be cleaned using a misting disinfecting machine. Maintenance is installing air filters on the bigger buildings for air quality. A plan for return of staff is slated for June 22<sup>nd</sup> but that is all dependent on testing.
