Welcome and Check-In

Dr. Woodward:

• Dr. Woodward shared the new meeting dates for the Student Success Committee which will be held every 3rd Thursday of each month, from 1:00 -2:00 p.m. Student representative will not be attending today's meeting.

Transfer Equivalency Self-Service -Dr. Jimenez:

- Dr. Jimenez shared his screen to do a presentation on the Transfer Equivalency Self-Service. This Transfer Equivalency platform is part of Elucian.
- The URL is website to help prospective students get an idea how those courses they have taken in other school's transfer, and how it may look like with a certificate/degree they want to pursue.
- The goals is to build this webpage more, currently 5 schools have been entered ELAC, El Camino College, Long Beach and Cerritos.
- Dr. Jimenez proceeded to show case how the website will be used.
- Student will get the chance to be able to look and see what classes they are missing and be able to download as a pdf or take it to a counselor.
- Dr. Jimenez shared with Drs. Woodward and Blonshine a link of how the webpage would look online.
- G. Manikandan asked when will the webpage be ready? Dr. Jimenez informed he is still asking to get input from faculty.
- Dr. Woodward asked if this title name and be rebranded? Dr. Jimenez informed he will take any feedback and present it.

Winter Refresher update, SSC activities, Just-in-time workshops Sarah George & Gayathri Manikandan:

- G. Manikandan gives an update on the Winter Refresher program went very well. A list of students was provided, those who failed the statistics course and English 101 course, Dr. Jimenez assisted in promoting and recruiting students through CRM Advice, 9 students attended from Math and 7 students for English, students who attended received incentives.
- G.- Manikandan suggest different sessions for High schoolers, so they are able to attend as well, possibly on Saturdays or asynchronous.
- Dr. Woodward suggested Manikandan input a request for data to follow along with students throughout the semester to see how they are doing.
