Meeting Minutes

- Review and Approve Minutes from Sept 27th
 - Minutes from the September 27th meeting were reviewed, a motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes.
- California Great Shake Out Drill
 - There was some discussion about the drill on Oct. 19th and the effectiveness of the new PA systems on campus. It was determined that the sound was more effective from the pre-recorded message than the message that was played into the system from another devise.
 - The volume in certain areas will likely be adjusted to make the speakers more effective. Other suggestions were to add an emergency tone prior to announcements to get the attention of the campus.
 - All the speakers in the Library are not connected which left some areas unable to hear the emergency announcement. That issue is currently being addressed.
 - Other suggestion regarding the Shake-Out Drill were to also send the notification through the Nixel system. Expanding the PA speakers in Tartar Village will be discussed. (budget)
