Meeting Minutes

- **Review and Approve Minutes from October 25th**
 - Minutes from the October 25th meeting were reviewed, a motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes.

- **Microsoft Infrastructure**
 - The Microsoft Infrastructure for Compton was approved at the Board Meeting (Nov. 21st). Adaptivedge will implement the new Microsoft environment for Compton College that will include configuration of the Active directory, Microsoft Azure Cloud Services, Microsoft Office 365, and Single Sign –on and security of sensitive information.
 - Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) will provide the HPE Synergy 12000 Frame with 4 servers and 40TB of storage. The new computing and storage equipment to serve the new Compton.edu network.
 - 3 to 6 more months 356 will be ready to go with compton.edu emails. Will begin using them next fall.

- **ERP/SIS System Update**

- Today was the due date for vendors for RFP, and only 1 vendor replied.
- (Andrei later reported the following to the committee). I reported that we received only one response to our Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) RFP. - The first demo starts next Tuesday, December 5th. Ellucian will be presenting their cloud-based Student Information System (SIS), Banner. The demo will be in the Allied Health Building, room 119, starting at 8 am. The demo agenda is attached. Everyone is invited to participate in the ERP/SIS products review.
- The target is to present final selection at January Board Meeting.
- There was some discussion with the committee members about Microsoft Office 365 and also about culture change with the campus community for storing work so it can be backed up.
