Meeting Minutes

- **Welcome and introduction**
 - New Technology Committee member math faculty Mr. Evan Skorka was introduced to the committee. All members also introduced themselves.

- **UPDATES:**

- **Review and Approve minutes from the Sept. 19th meeting**
 - A typo was pointed out in the minutes (and corrected)
 - A motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes as corrected.

- **Banner ERP/SIS implementation**
 - Finalizing 2 modules (BANNER student services & BANNER financial aid) will go live Jan. 14, 2019
 - Conducting final training and testing of the modules
 - Some integration with TOUCH NET
 - Student payment and ID card phase is beginning (TOUCHNET)
 - Phase I of implementation started

- **Banner Data Migration**
 - Dating back to 2015, 30,000 students (who declared Compton College as home campus) were sent permission for consent forms to transfer data and education history if they plan to re-enroll in Compton College.
 - Over 1000 students have provided authorization for consent to migrate their data.
 - Jihoon discussed the file migration process from El Camino to Banner

- **Nuventive Innovative- Resource Planning System**
 - This is a replacement for TRACTDAT or upgrade
 - First training sessions will begin tomorrow.
 - Should be familiar to anyone who has worked in TRACTDAT
 - TRACTDAT is still the base, there will be ongoing training

- **Compton College CCC Apply portal**
 - Currently 4 active projects
 - Redesigning portal layout for students, CCC Tech, ERP connect
 - In the future will be a direct connection to BANNER

- **Assistive Technologies- DECT/ 3Play Media partnership**
 - Cliff provided the committee with handouts about technology accessibility, accessibility standards, and information on 3CMedia Solutions
 - Cliff discussed the methods in which faculty can assure they are in compliance with technology accessibility requirements
 - There was discussion on how this information should be distributed to the faculty and administration and where this information should be included

- **DISCUSSION ITEMS :**

- **Technology Master Plan Update**
 - Discussion of technology policies and how they will tie into purchasing products and procurement.
 - Talked about District standards for faculty web sites (to meet compliance requirements)
 - The Tech & Academic Master Plan needs to include 508 compliance information.

- **IT Policy**
 - It was proposed to make recommendations at the next meeting
 - There was more discussion about IT Policies
