I. Minute Approval

III. Chat GPT

a. Academic Integrity Language

The committee reviewed the language in Board Policy AR5500 (Standard of Student Conduct). There was discussion about the language used in the sections regarding dishonesty as it related to cheating, plagiarism, and assuming the identity of another person.

Motion made by Jennifer Hill and seconded by Lynn Chung to recommend changes to the language in Board Policy AR5500 (*Due to multiple experiences by faculty in regards to the use of AI in violation of academic integrity, The Technology Committee recommends to the Academic Senate to revise the language of AR5500 Standard of Student Conduct and other relevant Board Policies to reflect the emergence of AS such as Chat GPT*)

IV. Invest more in Distance Education

a. Popularity of Online Instruction -There was discussion about investing more into Distance Education and having a dedicated person available to assist students with CANVAS. Arlen talked about the proposals for IT department such as an AV Specialist. Faculty and Staff must advocate for what they need as it relates to Technology.
