Student Success

- There has been over a 100% increase in the number of degrees and certificates awarded at Compton College since the 2013-14 academic year.
- In 2017-18, 642 Compton College students transferred to a four-year university, a 29% increase over the 2013-14 academic year. The most popular CSU destinations were Dominguez Hills and Long Beach, and the most popular University of California transfer destinations students were UCLA and UC Irvine.
- In 2017-18, there were 42 Compton College students who transferred to an in-state private institution, while 50 students transferred to an out-of-state institution.
- At the annual Academic Awards ceremony in May 2018, Compton College recognized the academic achievements of 59 honor students, three Presidential Scholars, and 41 scholarship recipients. Scholarships awarded to the students totaled \$31,600.



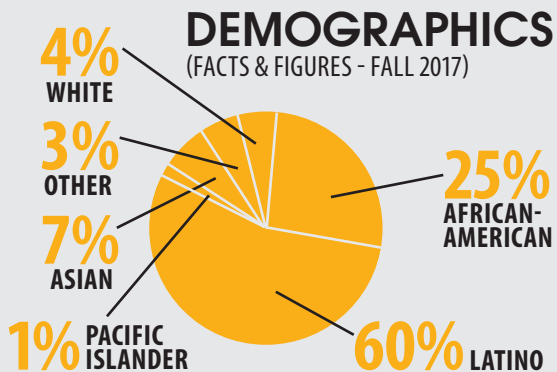

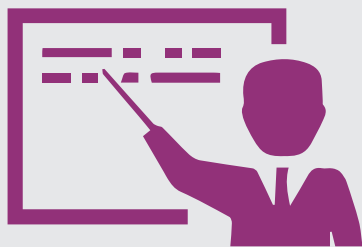

New and innovative academic programs have been added over the past 13 years, and in fall 2019, we will fully implement **Guided Pathway Divisions** to support student success.

- **Compton College Oliver W. Conner Promise Program** offers Compton and Lynwood unified school districts' graduates guaranteed admission and a year of paid enrollment fees plus \$800 in book vouchers. Students must attend full-time (12 units) beginning the fall semester immediately after graduation.
- The award-winning **Formerly Incarcerated Students in Transition (F.I.S.T.)** program provides equity, diversity and access to this student population. F.I.S.T. received the Dr. John W. Rice Diversity & Equity Award in 2017.
- Compton College has **Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) agreements** with the following colleges and universities: UC Davis, UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara, UC Santa Cruz, and Arizona State. TAG agreements are also available with the following **Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs)**: Alabama State, Clark Atlanta, Fisk, and Tuskegee.
- Compton College offers **dual enrollment college courses** in our local K-12 school districts, including AB-288 (courses that lead to an identified guided pathway, during the regular school day); **Early College** (courses taught at Compton College during the school day, for grades 9-12 with the intent of achieving an associate degree or completing the requirements for admission to the UC system); and **Afternoon College** (courses offered at the high school site after the regular school day). Since 2015, the number of dual enrollment students has increased dramatically, reaching 1,418 in fall 2018.
