









In 2024-2025, what kept you from participating in professional development activities?


How many professional development hours did you attend in the last academic year?


### Level of interest in the professional development topics to **Cultural Responsiveness and Data Utilization to Achieve Student Success:**


# Level of interest in the professional development topics to **enhance teaching**:



Level of interest in the professional development topics to **engage in curriculum development:**



Level of interest in the professional development topics to **enhance diversity and inclusion in the classroom:**




## Level of interest in the professional development topics to **improve assessment**:


## Level of interest in the professional development topics to **improve use of technology**:

Claude AI and Chat GPT. AI is also built into MANY programs without our knowledge or consent.



None at this time. However, may explore later once I learn more about what each platform offers and can be used ethically by students.


### Level of interest in the professional development topics to improve your **classroom management**:


### Level of interest in the professional development topics related to **health and wellness**:


# Level of interest in the professional development topics to increase understanding of Compton College policies and procedures:


## Level of interest in the professional development topics to **enhance work**:






## Preferred Types of Training

discipline focused and any support

Equitable pay so that all faculty can maintain a reasonable workload, and so we can retain faculty and staff. Paid community of practices with a commitment of 2 years for results.

Full funding of out of state conferences within my discipline

Pedagogy support for teaching high school learners in the Dual Enrollment classroom. Especially for off-site teaching.

Creating assessments that are "AI proof" or at least make it hard for students to use AI.

Creating lessons on Critical Media Literacy for students.

Critical training on AI with research on how it is impacting student reading levels and critical thinking. As well as its impact on the environment.

## Is there anything else we should know to help build a robust, useful professional development offering?

a variety of offerings is best

Consider using our faculty more often. Pay US to train faculty. Encourage and support the Community of Practices (where faculty can build community, share best practices, and address what we are seeing in our classrooms).

Robust training related to Dual Enrollment. Campus-wide training in reading pedagogy (this cannot be left to English alone; like writing and math, it must be reinforced in other disciplines).

For faculty, having other community college faculty members leading the trainings. Knowing they are in the classroom currently helps with buy-in from faculty participants.


Offer wellness for faculty. Too much is focused on student success but not faculty success. Adjuncts can't even receive health insurance.




