## El Camino College Math-23 Tracking Fall 2007 & Spring 2008



At El Camino College, Math-23 is a Basic Skills Math course that is three levels below transfer-level Math. In this study, students who enrolled in Math-23 for the first time during the terms of Fall 2007 and Spring 2008 were tracked until Summer 2009 and Winter 2010, respectively, to find how many students enroll and successfully complete the Basic Skills Math Track. Students that pass a course in one or more attempts during the time frame are counted in the success rate, regardless of the amount of attempts in the course.



The Fall cohort had almost double the number of first time Math-23 or 25 students than the Spring cohort. The Fall cohort also had higher success rates in all the Basic Skills Math courses. For both cohorts, the success rates only dropped slightly across the courses on the track.

Students that enrolled and passed Math-23 or 25 in Fall 2007 or Spring 2008 were tracked to find how many students were successful in other courses on the Basic Skills Math courses. The Fall 2007 cohort had slightly higher improvement rates than did the Spring 2008 cohort. Both cohorts had similar improvement rates in the two-levels below and one-level below courses with almost half of the students who passed Math-23 or 25 passing Math-40 and a quarter of the students passing Math-73 or 80.
