

## Crossover Enrollment: El Camino College and the ECC Compton Center 2006 to 2010

This brief highlights crossover enrollment between El Camino College (ECC) and the Compton Center (CEC) in order to address the perception that students are moving between campuses to fulfill their educational needs. Simultaneous (enrolled at both campuses in the same term) enrollment is provided for the terms Fall 2008 through Fall 2010. Data for students who leave one campus to attend the other is provided for the terms Summer 2008 through Fall 2010.

The number of students who enroll at both campuses in the same term is generally small. Fall 2008 and Spring 2010 had a larger number of simultaneous enrollments but even the 126 students in Spring 2010 only represents 1.7% of the CEC population and 0.5% of the ECC population. Further exploration has not yet suggested a reason why these two spikes occurred but investigation continues.



There were 406 students who utilized both campuses between Summer 08 and Fall 10. If students began exclusively at one campus but utilized both schools, they were more likely to finish exclusively at the second campus. Only 62 students can be considered "transfer" students after beginning exclusively at one campus and enrolling in their most recent term exclusively at the other, with the majority leaving ECC to go to Compton. The majority of students who used both campuses started at both. Almost half of the 321 students who did so enrolled in their most recent term solely at El Camino, while a third continued to use both campuses in their most recent term.
