Applicant Yield Rates El Camino College and El Camino College-Compton Center Fall 2009 to Fall 2013


This is a summary of the applicant yield rates for El Camino College and the El Camino College-Compton Center for the last 5 years.

El Camino College

At El Camino College, the number of applicants increased from 19,323 in Fall 2009 to 20,481 in Fall 2013. The applicant yield rate (percentage of applicants who enrolled at the college) was 43% in Fall 2009. In Fall 2010, the applicant yield rate decreased 6 percentage points to 37%. The applicant yield rate remained stable in Fall 2012 and Fall 2013 at 34% and 36%, respectively.




El Camino College-Compton Center

At the ECC-Compton Center, the number of applicants increased from 5,134 in Fall 2009 to 6,781 in Fall 2010. In Fall 2012, the number of applicants decreased to 5,054. The applicant yield rate was 42% in Fall 2009 and 39% in Fall 2010. Applicant yield rates decreased to 33% in Fall 2011 and Fall 2012.

Conclusion

The number of applicants to El Camino College increased in the last 5 years. At the ECC-Compton Center, after having nearly 6,800 applicants in Fall 2010, the number of applicants decreased to 5,142 in Fall 2013. The applicant yield rates at both El Camino College and the ECC-Compton Center have been stable the last 3 years. The 3 year average applicant yield rates for El Camino College and ECC-Compton Center are 35% and 33%, respectively.
