# El Camino College and El Camino College Compton Center **Applicant Yield Rates**




This is a summary of the applicant yield rates for El Camino College and the El Camino College-Compton Center for the last 5 years.

## **El Camino College**

At El Camino College, the number of applicants increased from 19,085 in Fall 2010 to 21,576 in Fall 2014. The applicant yield rate (percentage of applicants who enrolled at the college) has remain stable with a 5 year average applicant yield rate is 36%. From Fall 2013 to Fall 2014, the applicant yield rate increased 2 percentage points from 36% to 38%.




# El Camino College-Compton Center

At the ECC-Compton Center, the number of applicants decreased from 6,781 in Fall 2010 to 5,216 in Fall 2014. The applicant yield rate decreased from 39% in Fall 2010 to 33% in Fall 2010. Applicant yield rates remained stable from Fall 2011 to Fall 2013 with a 3 year average of 33%. In Fall 2014, the applicant yield rate decreased slightly to 30%.

## Conclusion

The number of applicants to El Camino College increased in the last 5 years. At the ECC-Compton Center, after having nearly 6,800 applicants in Fall 2010, the number of applicants decreased to 5,216 in Fall 2014. The applicant yield rates at both El Camino College and the ECC-Compton Center were stable from Fall 2011 to Fall 2013. In Fall 2014, the applicant yield rate for El Camino College increased 2 percentage points from the previous year while the ECC-Compton Center applicant yield rate decreased 4 percentage points from the previous year.
