El Camino College California Benchmarking Project Fall 2011



The California Benchmarking Project (CBP) is a joint effort between the Center for Urban Education (CUE) at the University of Southern California and California community colleges to design strategies and tools to promote excellence in basic skills instruction and a strong transfer culture.

An important starting point, according to CUE, is to disaggregate course success rates by race/ethnicity. Large differences in success rates signal areas that require additional focus and provide program planners and leadership with additional information about student achievement.

CBP Summary: El Camino College

For the CBP, course outcomes for Reading, Writing, English as a Second Language (ESL), and Math courses were calculated for Fall 2011. Each course disaggregates success rates by student race/ethnicity¹.

In Reading and Writing courses, the success rates for African-American students fell below average in every course with the exception of English-80. All other racial/ethnic groups had success rates above average with the exception of Hispanic/Latino students in English-80 and English-1A.

In ESL courses, the success rates for Hispanic/Latino students fell below average in every course. The Asian/Filipino/Pacific group is the majority in all ESL courses while there are small numbers of African and White students in these courses.

In Math courses, the success rates for African-American students fell below average in every course with the exception of Math-150 by at least 10 percentage points. Hispanic/Latino students have above average success rates in the first three basic skills Math courses (Math-12, Math-23 and Math-40), but fall below average in all remaining Math courses.

CBP Comparison: Fall 2009 & Fall 2011

Comparing Fall 2009 & Fall 2011 does not indicate any significant trends showing either positive or negative changes. A few of the variation numbers did increase a great deal but when you examine the population sizes there does not seem to be a large enough number from which to draw a conclusion.

El Camino College California Benchmarking Project: Course Outcomes by Ethnicity



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
