El Camino College California Benchmarking Project Fall 2013



The California Benchmarking Project (CBP) is a joint effort between the Center for Urban Education (CUE) at the University of Southern California and California Community Colleges to design strategies and tools to promote excellence in basic skills instruction and a strong transfer culture.

An important starting point, according to CUE, is to disaggregate course success rates by race/ethnicity. Large differences in success rates signal areas that require additional focus and provide program planners and leadership with additional information about student achievement.

CBP Summary: El Camino College

For the CBP, course outcomes for Reading, Writing, English as a Second Language (ESL), and Math courses were calculated for Fall 2013. Each course disaggregates success rates by student race/ethnicity¹.

In Reading and Writing courses, the success rates for African-American students fell below average in every course. All other racial/ethnic groups had success rates above average with the exception of Hispanic/Latino students in English-1A.

In ESL courses, the success rates for Hispanic/Latino students fell below average in every course except ESL 53A (Elementary Writing and Grammar). The Asian/Filipino/Pacific group is the majority in all ESL courses while there are low numbers of African and White students in these courses.

In Math courses, the success rates for African-American students fell below average in every course, ranging from 7% to 16%. Hispanic/Latino students have above average success rates in two basic skills Math courses (Math-12 and Math-40), but were at or below average in all remaining Math courses. Asian/Filipino/Pacific and Caucasian students were above average in every course.

CBP Comparison: Fall 2009-2013

Comparing Fall 2009, 2011, and Fall 2013 indicated no stable trends in success rates. Increased in success rates within each ethnic group was present, but was not shown to be statistically significant. The success gap between ethnicities decreased in several courses (e.g., Eng 1A and Math 150) and increased in others (e.g., Eng A and Math 40). This indicates no stable, general trend towards equal success rates between different ethnicities.

¹ All students qualified for the courses in which they enrolled either by a sufficient score on an assessment test or by passing the prerequisite course.


Ethnic Group Success Rate Trends by English Course












