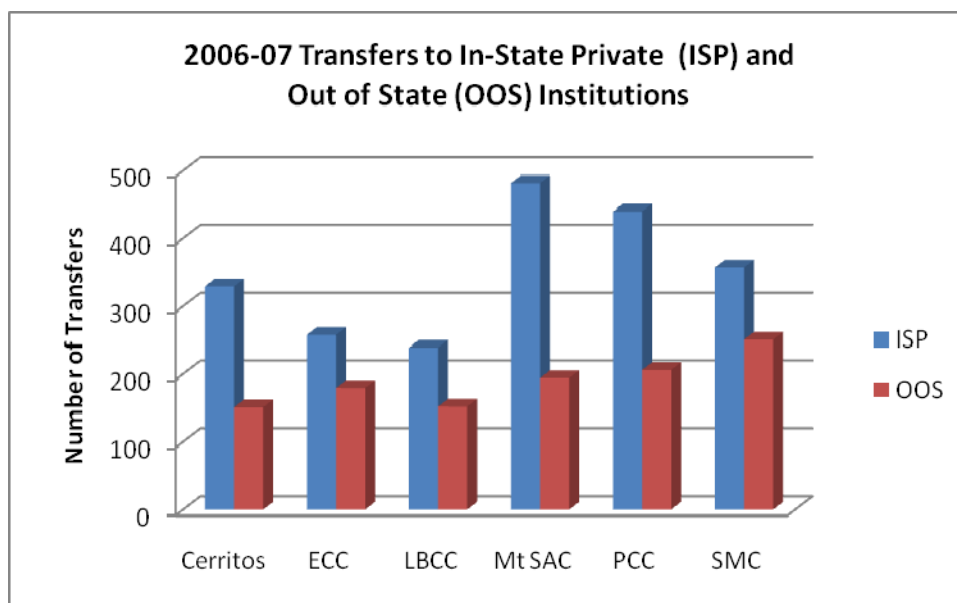


## Transfers to In-State Private and Out of State Institutions El Camino College Peer Group Report, 2006-2007

This report is a brief peer group summary of a recently-released Chancellor’s Office tally of community college transfers to in-state private and out-of-state 4-year institutions. The figures below include all students who transferred to one of the two groups of 4-year institutions in 2006-07. New students from the past 11 years who earned at least 12 units at a California community college were counted if they transferred in 2006-07.<sup>1</sup> See the original report for more information on student cohorts and data limitations.

The most common in-state private university was by far the **University of Phoenix** for ECC and most peers. SMC fed two privates in about equal numbers (USC and Univ. of Phoenix). The top out of state schools by much smaller margins were **Arizona State University** (AZ) and **UNLV**.

<sup>1</sup> Although peer colleges are of approximately the same size as El Camino, headcount enrollments varied considerably across the 11 years of the study. Therefore, comparisons should be made with caution.
