

## Fall 2022 Student Withdrawal Report

January 3, 2024


The Office of Institutional effectiveness distributed the Fall 2022 Withdraw Survey to student with a grade of "W."

- The survey was distributed to **376 students**; **53 responded** for a **response rate of 14%**.
- **About half** of student respondents **did not feel prepared** for the course they were attempting.
- The courses with the highest withdrawal numbers are as follows:

Due to ongoing health related issues with my back- I found the need to withdraw in order to take care of myself and focus on my recovery.

Homelessness as a single mother of four.

Didn't have any help with learning how to navigate on the laptop and the class instructions where hard to find, the Teacher put information in different places

I got into the class in el camino so I no longer needed to attend compton at that time

The course seemed to be hard. It was too much of a work load for me.

It required more time and requirements than expected. I have a job as a teacher have a background check, vaccines and a health check out done 3 months before the beginning of the class. I thought that I could use them, but I need to do it again.

I was going thru homelessness and I couldn't. Attend my classes

I was undergoing homelessness.

I withdrew from this course because it was a bit to difficult for me.

I didn't feel like I belonged and I kinda felt uncomfortable going to college

I never withdrew I was just facing alot of horrific situations that caused me to not make it to my classes

A family member passed away and I told my professor that I needed to take 2 days off. She dismissed my reasoning and said I was required to be in class.

I tested positive for COVID 19 at the beginning of the session, I wasn't able to continue due to medical issues related to COVID.

It was very disorganized as the first professor only showed up for one class and a second professor came in stating that she did not know who would take over the class.

You all need to reach out to theses professors who are quick and persistent in shooting emails as to announcements: assignment notices, deadlines, missed work.... and have them FOCUS on delivering relevant and timely need instruction material.

The professor rushed things and didn't reply to emails when needed help.

Large teacher dropped me from the class because of my lack of attendance. But I was busy with working and personal issues

The professors teaching methods was unfortunately a technique that I could not learn from, and my grandmother is passing and out into hospice, so I made sure to be at her side.

Had personal health issues which did not allow me to stay on track with class work

When I signed up for this class I thought it was going to be an online class with meeting times. I have not been in school since 2015 and I was never to type to learn on my own. It was very difficult for me to be able to work and learn without help

40 hr + work week was too much for this additional CIS class

I did not agree with the teaching method, the classes were informal and the teacher did as she felt rather than what was correct. I will not take this teacher again, but she covers most Child development courses in CCC. That is not good.

Because I need a tutor

This class was very difficult. It was hard to memorize 50 words+ No matter how hard I studied it just wasn't enough.


I had to take care of my. Mom she has diabetes and she lost her vision

Due to ongoing health related issues, I made the decision to withdraw in order to focus on my recovery. I was not feeling well during that time.


I just felt like I didn't belong and felt uncomfortable there






