NOTIFY CAMPUS POLICE (310-900-1600, ext. 2999)

immediately if you are aware of immigration enforcement activities on campus, i.e., a visit from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officials.

No employee outside of the Office of the President/CEO is authorized to accept legal documents from immigration enforcement officers.

2.

DOCUMENT and give Campus Police complete details of immigration enforcement activities as soon as possible. Include time, location, officer name/credential, and details of the request, if known.

3.

Call Campus PD at ext. 2999, then **ESCORT** the officer to the Public Safety Building at the Artesia Blvd. entrance.

Avoid answering any questions that could be construed as consensual contact while with the officer.

You may not give consent for an immigration officer to enter any nonpublic area of campus, including classrooms, office areas, etc.
