Full-Time Equivalent Students

Compton College's Full-Time Equivalent Students (FTES) numbers are steadily increasing, recovering from the decline experienced during the transition from El Camino Community College District and the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- The FTES goal for the 2024-2025 academic year is 4,125.
- We won't have positive attendance for spring until the end of the semester.

ACCREDITATION



Accreditation Update

- Accreditation Reaffirmed: Compton College's accreditation was reaffirmed for seven years with two commendations and no recommendations. (<u>ACCJC June</u> <u>17, 2024 letter</u>)
- Action Plan Monitoring: A chart tracks actionable items with quarterly updates (<u>January 2025 update</u>).
- Board Review: The Board of Trustees reviews the <u>ACCJC Standards</u> annually at their organizational meeting (summer 2025).
- Availability: Updates and reports are available in the monthly Board agenda.

Accreditation Update

In June 2024, the ACCJC, released new Standards.

- The ACCJC <u>Accreditation Handbook</u> provides a more extensive look into the Standards and includes rubrics for institutional alignment and transformation.
- The Accreditation Steering Committee, Consultative Council, and the Academic Senate have reviewed these Standards and rubrics as well as the Crosswalk for Committees and Offices.
- During the spring 2025 semester, the co-chairs will be visiting committees to engage them in the standards and rubrics applicable to the respective committee.



2025-2026 CCCD BUDGET



Tentative Budget Assumptions

- A. Estimated beginning balance: \$16,378,230 (2025 Estimated Ending Balance).
- B. Estimated revenue including state and local sources: \$52,835,450.
- C. Budget the General State Apportionment based on generation of **5,980 FTES** (Hold Harmless).
- D. Offering 1,476 sections for the 2025-2026 year.
- E. Cost of Living Adjustment (**COLA**) increase: **2.43**% (Governors Budget Proposal)
- F. Budget for projected **utility increases** of **1%**.
- G. Budget to fill the following **2 full-time faculty positions**:
 - 1. Culinary Arts
 - 2. Fire Technology
- H. Budget to fill the following classified position:
 - 1. Apprenticeship Specialist -Restricted Fund



Tentative Budget Assumptions

- I. Budget for the following one-time Augmentations/Enhancements (\$630,000):
 - 1. Enrollment Management Plan (\$100,000).
 - 2. Budget Augmentations One time (\$100,000).
 - 3. Student Meal Program (\$200,000). *
 - 4. Student Technology (\$150,000). *
 - 5. Summer Enrichment Activities (\$80,000).
- J. Budget for Line of Credit debt expense of \$775,069.
- K. Budget for Other Postemployment Benefit (OPEB) contribution of \$250,000.
- L. Reserve the following **expenditures** from the ending balance (**\$2,553,488**):
 - 1. Compton College Enterprise Resource Planning System (\$1,043,488).
 - 2. Compton Community College District Personnel Commission (\$400,000).
 - 3. Compton College Guided Pathways Programs (\$680,000).
 - 4. Compton College Strong Workforce Program (\$430,000).

Comprehensive Master Plan

- Board approved December 10, 2024: Compton 2035
- Emphasizes commitment to enhancing campus infrastructure, supporting student success, and fostering educational excellence.
- Serves as a strategic guide, aligning planning efforts with the budget and providing clear direction for future endeavors.
- Includes a Facilities Master Plan (pages 78-95)

Roadmap Toward the Goal

Compton College 2035 Singular Goal: accelerate student completion while advancing equity and success.

Builds on:

- structured approach of Completion by Design;
- o proactive support systems of Guided Pathways; and
- Vision 2030's Goals: equity in success, equity in access, and equity in support.

Compton 2035 Implementation Activities

Actions underway this semester to support Compton College 2035 include:

- Campus-wide survey to identify strengths and potential barriers to implementing the Plan
- Administrative Regulation 3250 Institutional Planning submitted for Board of Trustees approval
