**Re: 2022-23 COVID-19 Emergency Conditions Allowance Application**

Dr. Navarette,

Per our conversation, Compton Community College District is not submitting a [2022-23 COVID-19 Emergency Conditions Allowance Application](#). We are not submitting the application because Compton CCD's Full Time Equivalent Students (FTES) allocation levels are already outlined in [Assembly Bill – 183](#), which states:

C) (i) For purposes of computing the FTES attributable to this paragraph and subdivision (d), for seven fiscal years beginning in the fiscal year the Compton Community College District is accredited under the governing authority of the Board of Trustees of the Compton Community College District, the board of governors shall provide allocations to the Compton Community College District in an amount not less than the total amount that the district would receive if the level of attendance of FTES was the same level of attendance as in the 2017–18 fiscal year. The amount shall be adjusted to reflect cost-of-living adjustments, deficits in apportionments, or both, as appropriate for the applicable fiscal years.

As outlined in statute, Compton CCD has an FTES Hold Harmless Provision Extension through the 2025-2026 fiscal year.

While we are not submitting the 2022-23 COVID-19 Emergency Conditions Allowance Application, we intend to submit an Emergency Conditions Recovery Plan by your requested deadline of **February 28, 2023**. Our application will include components from our [Compton 2024 Enrollment Management Plan](#) and the [2022-2023 Compton College Outreach and Recruitment Activities Plan](#).
