Campus Community,

As we prepare for the 2021-2022 academic year, and taking into consideration the recent increase in COVID-19 infections, the District is preparing to require that all students and employees on campus, as well as employees traveling on behalf of the District, must be vaccinated. A resolution to this effect will be presented to the Compton Community College District Board of Trustees for approval on *Tuesday, August 17, 2021*. The resolution would require all employees and student-athletes to be fully vaccinated by *October 1*, *2021*, and would require all other students to be fully vaccinated by *January 1*, *2022*.

For employees to become fully vaccinated by *October 1, 2021*, the one-dose Johnson and Johnson vaccine must be received by *September 17, 2021*; an initial dose of the Pfizer vaccine must be received by *August 27, 2021* (with a second dose on *September 17, 2021*); <u>or</u> an initial dose of the Moderna vaccine must be received by *August 20, 2021* (with a second dose on *September 17, 2021*). St. John's Well Child & Family Center provides the COVID-19 Pfizer vaccine using our on-campus health center as a vaccination pod. The COVID-19 vaccine is FREE to all eligible persons (Visit the LADPH website for more info). Individuals may call 1-866-980-0870 to register for an appointment.

The decision to adopt a vaccine requirement is not negotiable and is not dependent on union approval. The District is prepared to engage in <u>effects</u> bargaining and will be meeting with the employees' unions for this purpose.

It is my sincere hope that <u>all</u> of our employees get vaccinated.
