Thank you to all involved in Early Alert at Compton College and the individuals who worked on our nomination application. As an Impact Award winner, Compton College will also receive a \$25,000 prize.

Los Angeles County COVID-19 Update

2023-2024 Enrollment Management Budget

The Compton College 2022-2203 Annual Plan allocated \$80,000 in Enrollment Management Funds to hire 15-20 student ambassadors to assist with implementing activities from the Compton College 2022-2023 Outreach and Recruitment Plan. Due to challenges with hiring student ambassadors, there has been a recommendation to hire three provisional program technicians instead. This recommendation was discussed at the *February 28, 2023*, Enrollment Management Committee Meeting. I approved that recommendation, and we are filling these positions.

CCSSE National Survey

This Spring, Compton College will participate in the Community College Survey of Student Engagement (*CCSSE*), a national survey of institutional practices and student behaviors during the spring term. *CCSSE*

(pronounced SEH-see) is an initiative of CCCSE at The University of Texas at Austin. *CCSSE* results will help us better understand our students' college experiences inside and outside the classroom and improve our programs and services to serve them.

Students are much more likely to respond to this survey if they hear about it from their instructors, especially if they are allowed 15-20 minutes to complete it. The survey will be available in a Canvas shell. If you are an instructor or a staff member who interacts with students, please encourage them to complete *CCSSE*. Students will be added to a Canvas shell and assigned the survey in that shell.

The baseball team played against Los Angeles Harbor Seahawks at home on *February 22, 2023*, resulting in a favorable win of 7-1 after a loss the day before. The baseball team also defeated Imperial Valley (11-9) on their home field, displaying great offense. Johnathan Enriquez, Roberto Bueno, and Jagger Rafkin scored two runs each. The team takes on West Los Angeles college today at 2:00 p.m. at home before going on the road to close out the series against Harbor College on *Friday, March 3, 2023*. The Tartar softball team displayed their skills in their first game of the season against Long Beach City College yesterday after a two-year hiatus. Although the game resulted in a loss, Destiny Vega hit her first run on the Viking field. Their home opener is on *Friday, March 3, 2023*, at 3:00 p.m. against the Cerritos College Falcons. Women's badminton is another sport that reappeared, having played their first game since 2019 last Friday against East Los Angeles College with a final score of 12-9. The team is set to play at Pasadena City College on *Friday, March 15, 2023*, at 2:00 p.m. Men's and women's track competed at the Cal State, LA Invitational on *February 25, 2023*. The team will prepare to showcase their talents at Viking Invitational on *March 10, 2023*, and the Ben Brown Invitation at CSU, Fullerton, on *March 11, 2023*.

President/CEO Closing the Loop

- 1. I approved sending a Compton College Faculty and Classified Staff team to the <u>California Dual</u> <u>Enrollment Equity Conference</u> in Bakersfield, CA, *May 2-3, 2023*. One of our College Futures Foundation grants will fund conference registration and travel.
- 2. After a lengthy process of trying to provide support and coverage for the vacant Director of Diversity, Compliance & Title IX position, I have selected Jennifer Burchett as the interim director for Compton College. Jennifer Burchett comes to us with a wealth of community college experience in human resources, specifically Title IX complaints and investigations, EEO planning, and compliance. Jennifer Burchett will start on *Monday, March 6, 2023*. Please note the permanent position of Director of Diversity, Compliance & Title IX is in the recruitment process and closed on *February 21, 2023*.
- 3. The Open Educational Resources Committee established the goal of 85-100% of course sections to utilize Open Educational Resources (OER) by 2035 to reduce the burden of textbook costs on students. The Academic Senate approved this goal during their June 4, 2021, meeting. A faculty workgroup was formed during the 2021 -2022 academic year with the support of the 20 MM Michelson Foundation Spark Grant to develop an Open Educational Resources Proposal, establishing a roadmap on how to increase the number of courses using OER materials. The proposal received approval from the Academic Senate on October 20, 2022. I am still reviewing the proposal and will provide a response to the Academic Senate in the coming weeks. However, I approved an additional \$200,000 from American Rescue Plan Funds to implement the Compton College OER Program this week. In addition to these funds, the College has requested and received Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) funding from the Chancellor's Office to support the College's OER efforts. The Chancellor's Office IEPI Team will visit the campus on March 15, 2023, and May 4, 2023, to speak with key stakeholders about increasing OER usage on campus.

Final Thoughts

This week, I began my tenure on the <u>National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity</u> (<u>NACIQI</u>). We had three days full of meetings that began at 6:00 a.m. It was interesting to learn about issues that many accrediting bodies face and how they address student outcomes and equity. As I serve on this committee appointed by Miguel Cardona, U.S. Secretary of Education, I look forward to sharing information with the <u>Compton College Accreditation Steering Committee</u>.
