Compton College Athletics Update

We finally had some sunshine allowing our Athletic Teams to play their games, including two baseball games against Cerritos College and Long Beach City College.

- In the last series game against Cerritos College, right-hand pitcher Joseph Giunta pitched seven innings allowing only three hits, one run, one walk, and three strikeouts in a 5-1 win over Cerritos College. In the Long Beach City College three-game series, utility player Tervell Johnson went 8 for 12 in three games, boasting a .667 batting average for the week. Tervell had 8 RBIs, four runs scored, two doubles, and 1 HR. In last Saturday's game, Roberto Bueno hit a walk-off home run to help the Tartars beat LBCC in the series' last game. The baseball team will enter this week playing non-conference teams, starting with Taft College, West Los Angeles College, and San Diego Mesa College. - The softball team continues to battle through conference games and shows promising signs of improvement by achieving small wins on and off the Field. The team is on the road this week, starting with El Camino College early in the week and ending with Mt. SAC and Pasadena City College. They will play doubleheader games against Mt. SAC and Pasadena to make up for the rain-out games during March.
- Since February 2023, our badminton student-athletes have competed, making each match highly interesting. The opposing schools have often stated that Compton College Badminton Team is "scary, highly athletic, and they have a big heart." This past week, the team traveled to El Camino College, competed with the #4 South Coast Conference team, and fought until the end. Compton took many El Camino players to a 3rd match, and although the Tartars lost 16-5, they did improve their overall performance. When asked how coaching these student-athletes felt, Head Coach Diego Beck (first year) exclaims, "It is a great group, who learn quickly and are very athletic. The future is bright for our (Badminton) team." Compton College Badminton had two games this week.
- Track and Field continue to compete and set personal records. The team is preparing for the South Coast Conference Prelims at the end of April by competing in the UC San Diego meet, and the Long Beach State meet next *Saturday*, *April 15*, *2023*.
