Subject: President/CEO Message - June 15, 2023

Campus Community,

Every Monday and Thursday, I review Compton College's enrollment data compared to our <u>Five-Year FTES Projections</u>, and I am highly encouraged by the summer and fall 2023 numbers. Having all Student Support Services housed in one location has helped, and the continued focus on recruitment and retention efforts has contributed to the positive enrollment numbers. *But the work can't stop*. We need to continue improving the enrollment processes, including how we collect inquiries and transition those individuals into successful registrations. The new 2023-2024 Outreach and Recruitment Plan will focus on new students, and retention activities will concentrate on current students and their term-to-term persistence.

Yesterday, I had the opportunity to attend the Compton College Summer Transfer Institute Orientation. We have a goal of 25 Compton College students taking an online Ethnic Studies 101 course, *June 20 through July 27, 2023*, and then participating in the Summer Residential Transfer Program at UC Irvine *July 7-16, 2023*. Thank you to the Transfer and Career Center for coordinating this program and Nathan Lopez for teaching the Ethnic Studies 101 course this summer. This is a beautiful opportunity for our students. In the next few months, we will have more conversations on campus regarding student transfer programs and explore creative ways to support our students through their transfer journeys.

Summer and Fall 2023 Enrollment Update

As of *today*, *June 15*, *2023*, Compton College has generated:

- 461 FTES for the **Summer 2023** term. Our fill rate for Summer is currently 69%, and seats filled is 3,798.
- 451 FTES for the **Fall 2023** term. Our fill rate for Fall is currently 16%, and the seats filled is 2,662.

2023-2024 Student Parking Permits

Current students may park free at Compton College through June 30, 2024, with a valid parking permit. Students must complete the online application (https://paymycite.com/Compton/parkingpermit.aspx) for their free 2023-2024 parking permit. Upon completing the online transaction, students will receive an email with a link to download and print their student parking permits. *Please note:* the 2022-2023 student parking permits

expire *June 30*, *2023*. Students must complete a new application online and download the 2023-2024 permit that is good from *July 1*, *2023*, through *June 30*, *2024*.

A one-week grace period for parking (in student lots only) will be provided for the winter and summer terms and two weeks for the spring and fall semesters for students to display a parking permit. No citations will be issued for vehicles properly parked in marked student spaces during this period; all other parking violations will be enforced.
