## Fall 2023 and Winter 2024 Enrollment Update

As of yesterday, October 26, 2023, Compton College has generated:

- 1,506 FTES for the Fall 2023 semester. Our fill rate for Fall is currently 67%, and seats filled are 10,549.
- 83 FTES for the Winter 2024 term. Our fill rate for Fall is currently 26%, and seats filled are 758.

With the passing of the Fall Second 8-week part of the term's census on *October 24*, this is the last enrollment snapshot for the Fall 2023 semester.

Winter 2024 enrollment opened on *October 24*, a week earlier than last year. After only two days of registration, there are already several sections over 65% of their capacity, including four that are full. Please encourage interested students to meet with a Counselor to see if a five-week Winter class (or two) might be a good fit for their academic and work/life goals.
