Summer and Fall 2024 Enrollment Update

As of *today*, *June 13*, *2024*, Compton College has generated:

- 539 FTES for the **Summer 2024** term. The fill rate is currently 75%, and the seats filled is 4,402.
- 695 FTES for the **Fall 2024** semester. The fill rate is currently 25%, and the seats filled are 4,290.

Summer classes begin *Monday, June 17*. Students may register for the first six-week and the eight-week sessions through 11:59 p.m. via MyCompton. After the first class meeting, students will need authorization from the instructor to add a class. Students are encouraged to make an appointment to see a Counselor and register for fall classes now, while there are plenty of classes to choose from.

In the <u>President/CEO Message – May 31, 2024</u>, I shared additional information about the Compton College Caring Campus Initiative and potential next steps. As we prepare for the start of the first summer session, I ask that everyone model the Caring Campus Behavioral Commitments. Let's all commit to demonstrating positive and student-centered customer service. As a friendly reminder, the behavioral commitments are:

- *Ten-Foot Rule:* Whenever a student is within 10' and seems to need assistance, take the initiative to approach them. Say hello, smile, and use a positive tone.
- *Nametags:* Wear name badges or lanyards with the college name on them so that students will know who to approach with questions.
- *Cross-Department Awareness:* Learn about other departments, so you know where to send students. Maintain accurate and up-to-date detailed directories.
- *Warm Referrals:* Call ahead or walk students to the office they need to get to. Follow up to ensure the student got there.
- First Week Greetings: During the first week of classes, set up information tables, meet students in the parking lot, and welcome students to the college. (Note: This commitment will continue to be implemented in fall and spring terms)

Enjoy the holiday on *Wednesday, June 19*, *2024*. The campus is closed in honor of Juneteenth, which commemorates the ending of slavery in the United States. The Compton CCD Board of Trustees approved the annual holiday at the <u>December 15, 2021, Board Meeting</u>. We also begin our 4/10 workweeks next week. <u>Board Policy 7170 - Remote Work</u> will remain in effect. When feasible, with the immediate supervisor's approval, an employee may work three days on campus and one day remotely for the summer term.
