Subject: President/CEO Message - August 29, 2025

Campus Community,

This was an incredible week at Compton College, and I really enjoyed seeing students on campus. Thank you all for your incredible hard work and dedication in making the first week of the fall semester a success! Your energy, teamwork, and commitment to our students truly set the tone for a strong start.

As we head into the three-day weekend (the campus will be closed on *Monday, September 1, 2025*, in observance of Labor Day), I hope you take a moment to enjoy some well-deserved rest. I'll keep this message short... or at least I'll try (you know how that goes—we always have so much great news to share!).

Over the past few days, I visited the Guerdon Factory in Boise, Idaho, where our volumetric student housing units are being built. The project is progressing quickly — delivery of the modular units is scheduled to begin early next week and is expected to be completed by late *September 2025*. These units will be stored both on campus and at an off-site location. The crane placement of the modular units at the housing site is tentatively scheduled to start on *September 30*, *2025*, and continue through *October 30*, *2025*. This phase will have a significant impact on campus operations. To support the delivery, part of Lot F will be fenced off for several months. During crane placement, expect temporary disruptions to parking and access in Lots E and F. Additionally, the East Greenleaf entrance to Main Campus Drive will be closed. Please watch for updates from our Facilities Department and in future President/CEO Messages. I'm very excited about this student housing project, which is scheduled to open in *summer 2027*.

Today's President/CEO Message includes a few key reminders: the in-person Student Forum on *September 10, 2025*, the importance of using Teams for communication among all employees, and a note of encouragement to support our Compton College athletics program this fall.

Fall 2025 Enrollment Update

As of *August 28, 2025*, Compton College has generated 1,652 FTES for the **Fall 2025** term. 11,517 (68%) of the available Fall seats are currently filled.

To help students complete their admissions applications, apply for financial aid, and register for fall classes, Student Services will remain open for extended hours through *Friday*, *September 5*, *2025*. Offices in the Student Services Building, as well as the Student Development Office (R-61), will be open *Monday through Thursday* from 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

President/CEO Closing the Loop

In the <u>President/CEO Message – August 22, 2025</u>, I shared that Compton CCD had been approved to receive \$2,697,708.38 in Employee Retention Tax Credit (ERTC) funds from the federal government. However, this was only a notice of approval; no funds were actually received. On *August 26, 2025*, we received a follow-up notice from the IRS stating that the credit had been reversed. We are currently awaiting further details from the IRS regarding the cause of this issue, and we will work with CDWL to file an appeal. Updates on the status of the ERTC funds and the final allocation plan will be shared in future <u>President/CEO Messages</u>.
