**Subject:** Confirmed COVID-19 Case at Compton College - May 10, 2021

Campus Community,

On **Friday, April 30, 2021**, Compton College received notification that an individual tested positive for COVID-19, the 2019 novel coronavirus disease. The individual was tested on **Thursday, April 29, 2021**, and was confirmed to have COVID-19 on **Friday, April 30, 2021**. The individual's identity and personal information are considered confidential and may not be disclosed to protect this individual's privacy. Through our contact tracing, on **Tuesday, May 4, 2021**, we confirmed the individual was last on campus on **Wednesday, March 10, 2021**. Since the individual has not been on campus while infectious, no impact on other College community members has been identified.

The [Compton CCD Pandemic Outbreak - Emergency Operations Plan](#) guides our response to the possible scenarios that may occur as the COVID-19 situation progresses. Compton CCD is operating at **Level 3 – Moderate Infection Rate**. Compton College is presently offering alternative academic instruction and online student support services. I am in the process of sending communication to the campus community. The information regarding the confirmed case will also be posted on the college website.
